EcoCamp

For incoming 5th-6th graders

All EcoCamps stay at one location for 3 days, and backpack for 2 days.

June 8-12 Beavers and Bugs

Campers will learn about wetlands and woodlands, beavers, insects, and the important roles they play in our ecosystems.

July 13-17 Hut Habitats

Build, destroy, build! Forts, fires, frolic, campers will learn to safely use tools while doing service to support the habitats around the ERC's backcountry huts and learn why they matter.

July 27-31 Planets and Pines

Planets and Pines invites young explorers to learn about the night sky and what happens in the forest after dark, combining astronomy, ecology, and outdoor adventure in an unforgettable summer experience.



EcoTrips

For incoming 7th-9th graders

June 22-26 Rivers, Roots, & Ropes

On this trip, participants will learn how to rock climb outdoors to carry out scientific studies! They'll explore natural geologic features in southern Idaho, learning about rock and river ecosystems. Leaders will grow as a team while canoeing and backpacking.

Aug 8-14 Trails to Leadership

Experience the most epic week in the outdoors with the ERC! Prepare for middle and high school by building leadership qualities through teamwork, learning hard skills such as setting up a shelter, and persevering through challenges in the backcountry with a group of super awesome people. This radabonzical trip is our longest program, lasting 7 days, and is the only program where participants backpack everyday and sleep in a new location each night. **There are two sessions available, one all girls trip and one all boys trip.**
